## Where we meet in The UK

In the UK, Section meetings with a talk followed by supper are held in CA House twice a year, in November and February, along with Zoom meetings on varied topics every month or so during autumn, winter and spring. We hold a weekend of talks



about both technical aspects of Med sailing and favourite cruising grounds at our Mediterranean Seminar in March at CA House. We also hold a Med Section Summer Party somewhere in the UK in August, which is a great opportunity to meet old and new members and of course the Section Secretaries who organise our events.

#### The Mediterranean

The Section aims to hold a sailing rally somewhere in the Mediterranean every year and a winter 'land-based' rally some years. The social side of our Section is very important and we encourage members to organise informal local 'get-togethers' where members meet for dinner and "cruises in company". These have been very successful, numbers varying from half a dozen to fifty or so people. Some members post details of their proposed sailing ground so that those in the same areas can meet up and sail together informally, if they wish. All members fly a CA burgee which is a great way of welcoming other members along for a chat, which often morphs into an invitation to come on board.

### **Being Part of our Section**

The Section communicates with its members electronically where possible and makes strenuous efforts to keep members updated with 'Mediterranean' information. We have our own Section pages within the CA website. We also have an occasional newsletter with important updates, more light-hearted news and events from members.

#### **MedNet Forum**

Is an interactive email network where questions are posted and information shared. Topics covered are wide ranging, from queries about gear, boat maintenance and repair professionals, to new regulations and procedures, to friendly restaurants and the best anchorages. One of the many outstanding features of this system is that members who cannot or do not want to receive emails can switch it off, but all the messages that they have missed can be viewed at a later date via the CA website on the MedNet forum.

### **CAptain's Mate**

The CA app 'CAptain's Mate' is being used extensively by our members to access and submit Cruising Reports. We have now collated some 11,000 Mediterranean Cruising Reports, meaning that information is being continually updated by members. It is readily accessible both at home and while on board. We have extensive coverage of all the Mediterranean islands and the northern coastal areas. It also has an optional switch on/switch off "Friends" feature which enables you to see CA boats moored or anchored nearby.

#### **Presentations from the Med Seminars**

The Mediterranean Seminar weekend is one of the highlights of the Med Section UK events. We try to provide a good mix of technical and regulatory information on Saturday mixed with some lighter topics and ending with an optional Seminar dinner. On Sunday members present talks about various cruising areas in the Med which they know well so sharing their knowledge and expertise. We save the powerpoint slides and upload them onto the website each year so that they are available for all members at all times. For the 2025 seminar we plan to record the talks and upload them onto the CA website which will make the seminar even more accessible, and possibly to live-stream some of the talks.

Currently we have presentations covering a wide variety of topics from our most recent seminar weekend in March 2024 and going back to 2010!
