Cruising in Company

The aim of the Cruise In Company is to give boat owners the experience of a long passage (such as crossing the Channel or going to the Netherlands) whilst enjoying the security and safety of completing the passage with experienced skippers and on arrival the chance to meet other motorboat owners and learn from them.

Slower boats, with a cruising speed of less than 19 kts, will be in one group and faster boats in another. As the arrangements for berthing will be made by the organisers, and advice given on entry requirements will be made by the organisers, this stress will also be removed. For experienced boaters this will be the chance to meet old friends and make new ones.

Zoom talks

Stabilisers - Many motorboats would benefit from some form of stabiliser. Golden Arrow have kindly agreed to explain about their range of Interceptor, fin and gyro stabilisers.

Breakdowns - Prevention being better than cure Sea Start (the Solent breakdown service) will explain what commonly goes wrong, how to prevent it from happening and if it does happen what you can do about it.

Still boating - Never mind your age. Gilbert Park will talk about his top tips to make motor boating still comfortable and safe as the aging process catches up with us all.
