Programme

Saturday 3rd May

Passage Challenge – predict your time of arrival to Woolverstone, however you travel, and win a prize. See separate instructions.

1730 "Pontoon Party" – held indoors at RHYC upstairs in the Orwell Room, a chance to meet the other participants, please bring your own **glasses**, a **drink and a little food to share**, savoury or sweet.

The RHYC Bar and Galley will be open over the weekend from 1100 till 2200, food until 2100.

Sunday 4th May

Outing to Felixstowe

0915 Meet on the RHYC lawn and depart for Felixstowe in shared cars.

1000 Drive into the Landguard Fort car entrance and park in the Felixstowe Museum car park free to us all day by special arrangement (see map).

Coffee/tea at Felixstowe Museum followed by guided tour.

1130 Landguard Fort (next door). Audio guided visit. Members of English Heritage enter free.

1230 Participants may wish to have lunch at the View Point Café (100 yards). However, this is a very popular venue, be prepared to queue. There is another café, called Sea You Café, just over one mile walk along the front shortly past the NCI Martello Tower.

Alternatively, take Bus 77 from outside the Fort to Felixstowe seafront for lunch.

Afternoon: The Historic Vehicles taking part in the annual Ipswich to Felixstowe Road Run are due to start arriving on the Felixstowe promenade from 1200 and can be viewed during the afternoon. Last year there were 500. Finding a parking space there is likely to be a nightmare, so leave cars at the Museum and walk or take Bus 77 to Felixstowe.

Sunday Evening Event

1730 Royal Harwich Art Club Exhibition, private viewing with a pre-dinner glass of wine.

1830 for 1900 Three course informal Dinner including sweet bites and tea/coffee followed by

"The Hanse and East Anglia" by guest speaker Malcolm Harding. Extensive evidence of a mysterious German organisation known as the Hanseatic League was unravelled by Malcolm during three years of cruising around the Baltic. Having further researched this League, Malcolm has collated his findings into an illustrated talk which charts its beginnings, achievements and eventual decline.

Monday 5th May

1000 Meet on the RHYC lawn for a walk through the woods to the Butt and Oyster and treat yourselves to a drink.

Arrival by Boat, Car, Caravan or Motor Home

Arrival by boat at RHYC Marina (preferential mooring rates)

- Berth Masters, 07742 145994 and VHF Ch.80, are on duty to assist but are not always present during quieter periods.
- Alternatively, call 01473 780319, if arriving during office hours, Monday to Friday 0900 to 1600.
- If there is no answer, please tie up to a hammerhead 'V' pontoon and enquire at the bar.
- Arriving from Harwich, the first row of pontoons is Row A. Rows B and C are within the marina pond, and Row D is the row nearest the Orwell Bridge. Berths are numbered from 1, starting from the first berth inside the hammerhead.

Arrival by car, see "Directions to RHYC" which are separately downloadable. Free car parking in the RHYC car park.

Arrival by caravan or motorhome: contact MDL Marina on 01473 780206 for instructions, booking and payment.
