

Protocol for Entry and Exit requirements for non-Schengen mariners June 1st 2024

From June 1st France has permitted designated marinas to complete the Entry/Exit process for third country nationals arriving in via France. These locations are in additions to the official Ports of Entry. At least 24 hours in advance of arrival or within 24 hours of leaving the previous destination, the Préavis (Crew Manifest), obtainable by email, should be completed and returned by email. Inclusion on the list below does not guarantee that a marina will implement this protocol. Mariners are advised to contact their intended port of entry/exit well in advance. It is possible that marinas attached to a POE may also implement this protocol.

- Entry/Exit may be made at either a Port of Entry or an approved marina
- The Préavis must be emailed back to the marina prior to arrival or presented in person on arrival.
- The entry/exit form(s) will be stamped, not the passport.
- Forms should be kept with the passport.
- It is advised that each member of the crew retains a copy of the stamped form.
